Early Childhood Screening is available to your child through School District 622. Although it is optional for children attending non-public schools\*, this screening provides you with developmental information about your child:

- vision and hearing check
- · growth screening
- immunization review
- developmental progress using a standardized tool
- · family health and development review
- information and resources for your child

This free service is offered to children from three years of age to those starting kindergarten in the fall.
